Proverbs 4:18 NIV

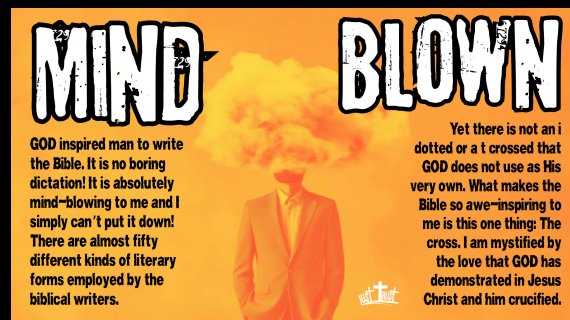
It has taken a long time for me to learn this. But oh, how wonderful a truth it is! It's like the same power that raised Jesus from the dead is

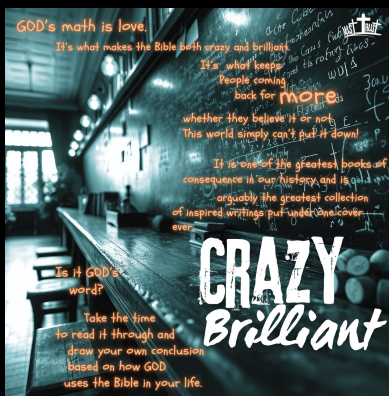
