

Wait.

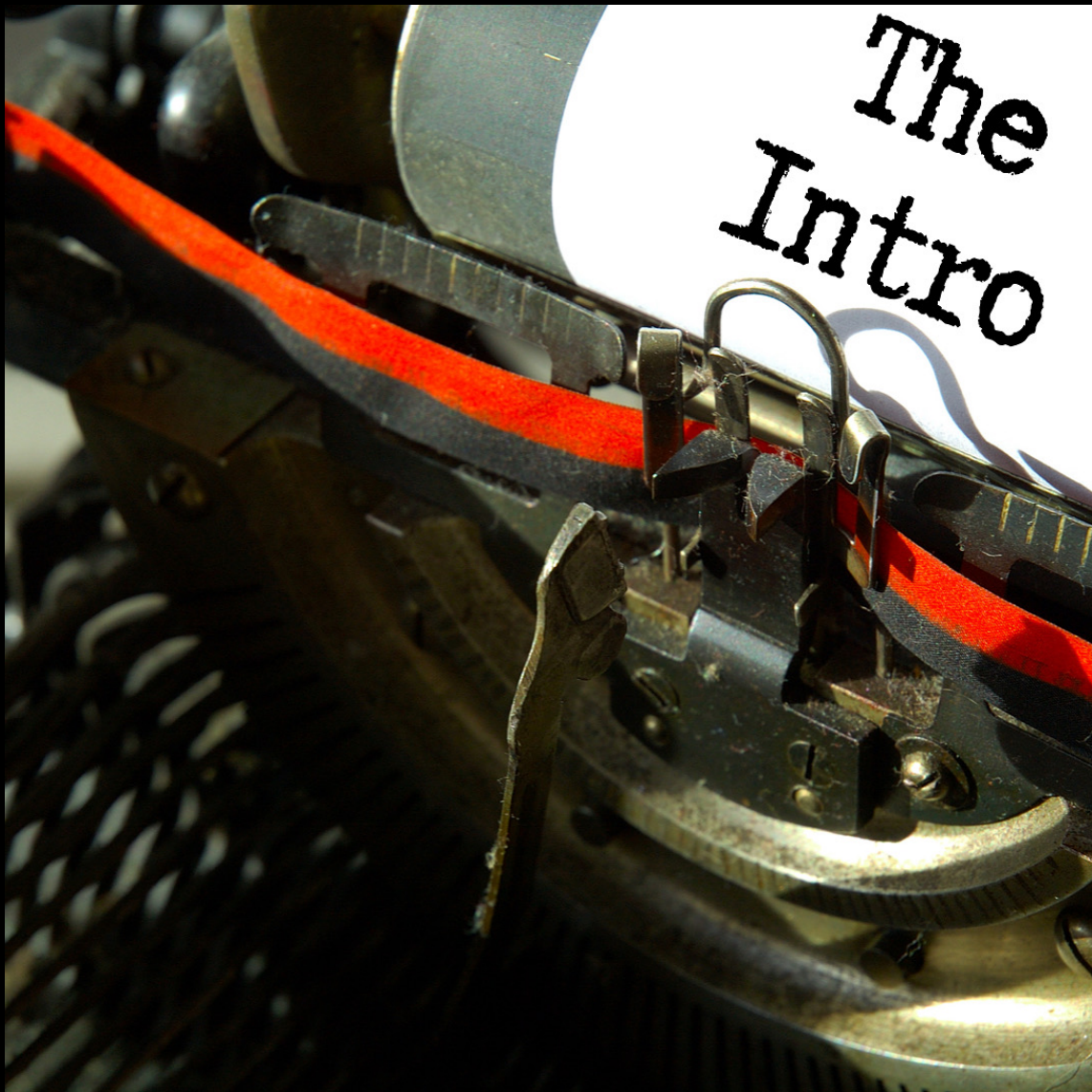
I was tempted to stop at just wait. Ha Ha.
